*For IANT Community Connect – Supporting Small Businesses & Strengthening Community Partnerships*

## 1. Booth Eligibility & Registration

- Open to **small businesses, startups, home-based businesses, and service providers.**
- All vendors must complete the official **IAN T Vendor Registration Form.**
- Booth confirmation is subject to **availability and approval** by the IANT organizing committee.
- Vendors must comply with all **city, county, and venue regulations.**

## 2. Booth Setup & Timings

- **Setup Window:** Vendors may begin setting up **2 hours before event start time.**
- **Operational Hours:** Booths must remain open for the **entire duration** of the event.
- **Teardown:** Vendors may begin teardown **only after the event concludes.**
- Early exit is **not permitted**, as it disrupts the community experience.

## 3. Booth Space & Equipment

- Each vendor will receive:
  - **One 10x10 booth space**
  - **One table & two chairs** (unless otherwise specified)
- Vendors must bring:
  - Tablecloths, banners, display stands
  - Extension cords (if electricity is approved)
  - Any additional décor or promotional materials
- Booths must be kept **clean, safe, and visually appealing** at all times.

## 4. Electricity & Special Requirements

- Limited electrical access is available **by prior request only.**
- Vendors must indicate electrical needs during registration.
- High-power appliances may require **special approval.**

## 5. Product & Service Guidelines

- All products/services must be **family-friendly** and appropriate for a community event.
- No items that violate **copyright, trademark, or safety regulations.**

- Food vendors must have:
  - Required **health permits**
  - Proper **food handling certifications**
  - Compliance with **city food safety rules**

## 6. Sales, Payments & Taxes

- Vendors are responsible for:
  - Their own **pricing**
  - **Payment collection systems** (cash, card, QR, etc.)
  - **Sales tax compliance** as required by Texas law
- IANT does **not** provide POS systems or change.

## 7. Booth Conduct & Community Standards

- Vendors must maintain a **professional, respectful, and community-friendly** environment.
- No aggressive sales tactics, loud audio, or disruptive behavior.
- All displays must remain within the assigned booth area.
- Vendors must follow instructions from IANT staff and volunteers.

## 8. Marketing & Promotion

- Vendors may distribute:
  - Flyers
  - Business cards
  - Samples (if approved)
- No roaming solicitation outside the booth area.
- IANT may feature selected vendors on **social media** or event materials.

## 9. Safety & Compliance

- All equipment must be **safe, stable, and hazard-free**.
- No open flames, hazardous materials, or unsafe electrical setups.
- Vendors must comply with **venue safety rules** and **emergency procedures**.

## 10. Cancellation & Refund Policy

- Cancellations must be submitted **in writing**.
- Refunds (if applicable) follow the event's official refund policy.
- No refunds for no-shows or late arrivals.

## 11. Liability

- Vendors are responsible for their own merchandise, equipment, and valuables.
- IANT is **not liable** for loss, theft, or damage.
- Vendors assume responsibility for any damage caused to the venue or event property.

## 12. Community Commitment

- Uplifting local businesses
- Strengthening nonprofit partnerships
- Creating a positive, inclusive environment for families
- Contributing to the cultural and civic fabric of North Texas
